

標題	2026 Mother' s Day Face-to-Face Family Visitation Event
內文	<p>To celebrate Mother' s Day and strengthen the emotional bond between inmates and their families, this institution held a "Mother' s Day Family Visitation Event" on May 7, with one session each in the morning and afternoon. A total of 220 inmates and 367 family members participated. The atmosphere throughout the event was warm and touching. In addition to carefully arranging the visitation process, the institution also displayed anti-fraud awareness posters and played fraud prevention videos at the venue to remind inmates and their families to remain vigilant against scams.</p> <p>The Warden stated that family support plays a crucial role in helping inmates reform and reintegrate into society. Through the Mother' s Day visitation event, inmates were not only given the opportunity to express their inner feelings, but were also able to repair parent-child relationships and strengthen their confidence and sense of responsibility for their future return to society.</p> <p>In addition, the Warden, accompanied by nine distinguished guests including Director Shen Mei-li of the Ciaotou Branch of the Taiwan After-Care Association, personally attended the event to express their care and concern. They greeted each inmate and family member individually and presented carnations to honor the great mothers present at the event. Furthermore, a Mother' s Day Family Day activity was also organized. In addition to an inspirational talk delivered by Pastor Pan Chih-hao of the Prison Fellowship Taiwan, licensed psychologist Chen Yi-ping led inmates and their families in a stress-relief colored salt art activity,</p>
